### All Weather Pitch project

The all-weather pitch at the Juniors was first built in 2001 and covers an area of 1600 square metres. The surface is now badly worn and needs refurbishment. The normal lifespan of such a pitch is 10 years so we've done extremely well to make it last this long! This pitch is a much-needed area for the school to be able to offer year-round outdoor learning, sports and activities.

We propose to replace this with a new high-quality all-weather playing surface which could be used for a range of different sports. We will believe there is an opportunity for the school to improve facilities by installing facilities such as floodlighting and an outdoor toilet block. This will enable the school to let these facilities to the wider community, thus enabling everyone to lead healthy and active lives. These lettings will also provide an income that will help fund future developments of this area.

As you can imagine, this will be a very expensive project, so will be fundraising through the PTA as well as looking for grants to support us. If you have any contacts who would like to sponsor the project etc., please let us know.
